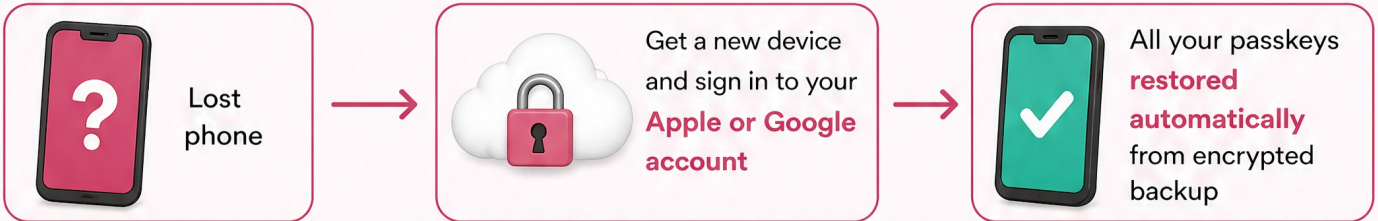


Passkeys in real life

The practical stuff — your questions answered.



What if I lose my phone?



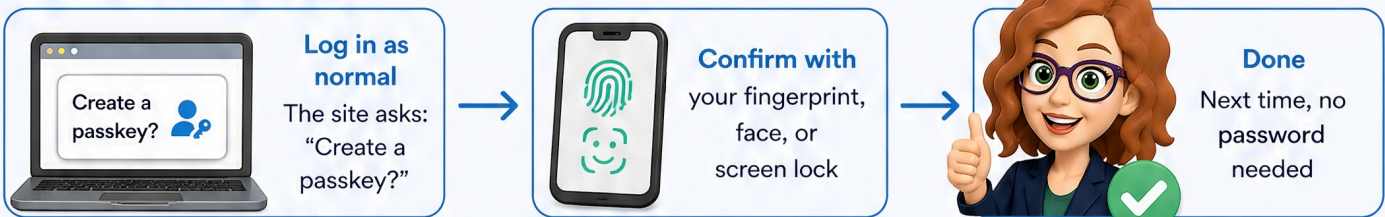
Your passkeys are backed up (encrypted) through iCloud or Google.
New device + same account = all your passkeys come with you.
Most services also still let you log in with a password during the transition.

I use more than one device — how does that work?



You can also create separate passkeys on each device — most services allow it.
Lose one device? The others still work independently.

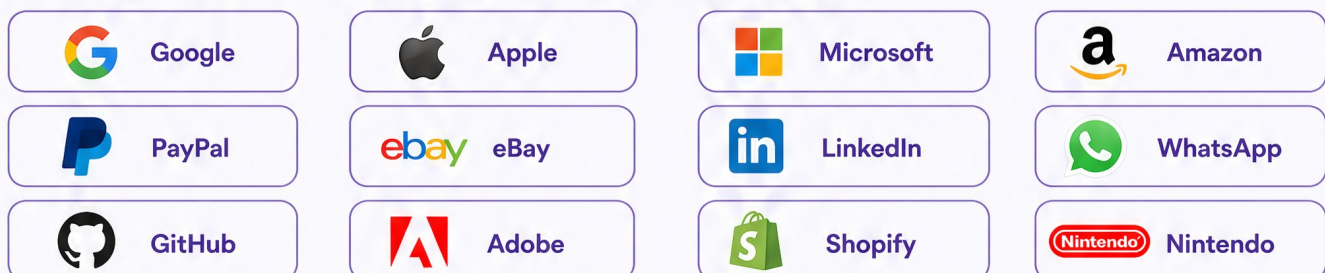
How do I set one up?



That's it. About 30 seconds. You'll never type that password again.
You'll see the option in your account security settings, or the site will offer it at login.
